but the end is in sight for the vacancy. Christopher Davis's licensing as Rector of the Wulfric Benefice will take place in St Bartholomew's Church on Thursday, 13th January. We look forward to welcoming him and his wife, Mary, to Crewkerne, and pray that they and we will be greatly blessed by God as we move forward together into whatever the future may hold for us.

Jonathan Morris retires on 21st November, and sadly there is no likelihood at present of his being replaced. Though his ministry has been mainly in the villages, it has been much appreciated also at St Bartholomew's. He has been invaluable in maintaining the links with the schools of the town and the villages. During the current vacancy he has conducted almost all the weddings and funerals. We shall be saying our goodbye to him at St Bart's at the benefice Eucharist at 10 am on 31st October.

Unfortunately, the end is not in sight for the Covid pandemic. Despite the successful vaccination programme in this country, the number of cases is still increasing. Too many people it seems feel that the worst is over and they no longer therefore need to stay cautious.

I believe we should remain cautious. By the time you read this I should have had my booster jab. If you are offered a booster, please take it. If you haven't been vaccinated yet, get vaccinated. We are continuing to ask all who come to the church, whether for services or for concerts or other events, to wear masks, to use hand sanitiser, and to allow safe space for others.

We know that some people are still wary of mixing with others, and so, as the Church of England is encouraging us all to do, we are moving towards the live streaming of our services. Instead of a pre-recorded service, it will be possible to watch the actual Sunday service online. You can find these services by going to YouTube and searching for St Bartholomew's Crewkerne or via our website, www.stbartscrewkerne.org. Please be patient with us! We hope that our standard of performance will improve as we get used to the technology! The camera is at the back of the church, so, apart from the clergy and lesson readers, most people will only be seen back view. If you don't want to be filmed at all, please sit at the back of the church.

May God's love, peace and joy be with us all.







THE BISHOP'S LETTER



There is much to do

Our church faces many challenges about funding, organisation, credibility and appropriate approaches to mission. Where might modern slavery fit in? Bath and Wells is a leading light within the Church of England in terms of a positive and effective response to the growing evil of modern slavery. On behalf of the Clewer Initiative, which coordinates the Church of England's work in this area, I would like to say a huge thank you to David Maggs, Sian Owen and others. They have helped the diocese lead the way in raising awareness, offering training to establish community resilience, fight back against the phenomenon of county lines (the involvement of children and young people in drug trafficking), and pioneered the development of partnerships which enable the church to play a key role in both care and prevention. Bath Abbey has been doing some ground-breaking work about monuments and the transatlantic slave trade with an approach which will be very helpful to others. Yet, with modern slavery increasing, there is much to do. Jesus calls us to love God and our neighbour as ourselves. The gospel makes clear that the neighbour is not just the person next door, but is particularly the person everyone easily passes by - while they are suffering without hope. In Matthew 25 Jesus makes it clear that we meet Him in the poor and oppressed – or in Clewer's words, Hidden in Plain Sight.

In the modern rush to grab cheap goods and services, we rarely notice those who may suffer and are criminally controlled in order to provide them. As we rightly reorder our priorities as churches, our ways of working, our mission and service — modern slavery is a key indicator of whether we aim to serve the church as our own safe place, or whether we aim to be out on that road between Jerusalem and Jericho, looking to encounter and rescue and raise up those who are trapped and suffering and generally ignored. Let us not rest on our laurels, but build upon our work so far, so that others may be brought good news, embraced into our communities, and given confidence to know the love of God through the love of their neighbours.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

'With curds and milk from herd and flock and with fattened lambs and goats,

with choice rams of Bashan and the finest grains of wheat. You drank the foaming blood of the grape.'

Deuteronomy 32:14



EASY MOUSSAKA

2 large or 3 small Aubergines 4 Potatoes peeled and sliced 2 Garlic Cloves finely chopped 750g minced Lamb 75g Butter 75g Flour 1 glass of Red Wine

Olive oil 1 large Onion 2 tsps. Cinnamon 1x600ml Passata 2 Eggs 600ml Milk

Heat the oven to 190C/fan 170C/gas 5. Brush the aubergine with olive oil and season, put them in a single layer on non-stick baking sheets. Cook for 30-40 minutes, turning once, until they are tender and golden.

Cook the potatoes in boiling salted water until just tender then drain well.

Fry the onion in a little oil until soft then add the garlic. After a minute add the mince and brown it, Add the cinnamon, wine and passata, season and simmer for about 30 minutes until any liquid has evaporated.

Heat the butter in a pan, stir in the flour and cook for a few minutes. Gradually add the milk, stirring until you have a smooth sauce. Season. A little grated nutmeg may be added to the sauce.


Turn the oven down to 180C/fan 160C/gas4. Layer the lamb, aubergine and potato in an ovenproof dish. Whisk the eggs into the white sauce and spoon it over the top. Bake 30-40 minutes until the top is puffed and dark golden brown. Leave to sit for 10 minutes before cutting into squares to serve.

Serve with a Green Greek Salad.

GEOFFREY SEYMOUR CLARKE



In 1971, following Navy postings to Singapore and Hong Kong, Geoff and his Danish wife Birgitte searched between Yeovilton and Portland for a house with a double garage for his vintage Talbot motorcar. They settled on The Hermitage in Crewkerne, and grew to love the town and its beautiful church.

For 50 years Geoff was a regular worshipper at St. Bartholomew's. He left the Royal Navy in 1977, and inquired of God whether to seek ordination, but felt the LORD wanted him to serve in other ways. Geoff focussed on Crewkerne, becoming mayor from 1994 until 1998, when the swimming pool was built, and also assisted Chubb's Almshouses and the Day/Henhayes Centre, negotiated to bring Waitrose to Crewkerne, and prevented building on Bincombe Hill.

Christianity for Geoff meant a deep, humble reverence for Almighty God. He persuaded Crewkerne cinema against showing the blasphemous film *The Life of Brian*, and donated Bibles for each pew in St. Bartholomew's.

Geoff was diagnosed with Parkinson's in 1992. He fought the disease without complaint for 30 years, and was granted his last wish of dying at home, in the company of Birgitte and their children Philip, Christopher and Susanna. He was 84.
