FROM THE RECTOR

"Poirot," I said. "I have been thinking." "An admirable exercise my friend. Continue it." — Agatha Christie, Peril at End House

One of my great privileges as the "vicar" is to go into the local church primary schools to do assemblies — or "collective worships". We have three church primaries in the benefice, together with Wadham, our church secondary school — and they all do a great job!



One of the reasons I enjoy assemblies so much, though, is the question time we normally have towards the end of each session – in which questions often come thick, fast and difficult!

The questions themselves are great: Where did God come from? How could Jesus' death bring us forgiveness? How can we believe in a God we cannot see? Is it always loving to tell the truth?

It isn't just the questions that are good though — it's the questioning — and the faces that are often deeply thoughtful. To be honest, I get much more rigorous and honest questioning from these children than I do from adults. And that is great...

After all, I don't think it's my job to go into the schools (or into other places) and tell people what they must believe, but as clearly as possible to explain what the Christian faith is and present the reasons to believe it. Then my prayer is that people will genuinely think for themselves and make their own mind up. That's vital, not least from a Christian perspective. True Christian faith always involves thinking for ourselves about Jesus Christ – as we reflect on what others say.

The problem is of course that we often don't keep thinking. Isn't it true that "life" often just "takes over"? Isn't it true too that our minds are then often over influenced by popular opinion, by what people around us think. Isn't it true that it's then all too easy to begin to assume that Christianity is not true — or really true — not because we have thought about it, but because we long ago stopped thinking much about it! In other words, people very often think that Christianity — and vicars — are afraid of difficult questions. But I say — bring them on! If you have difficult questions to ask about God — please don't shrink from talking to me about them. Let's be more like the children...



THE BISHOP'S LETTER







What a joy! In response to God's immense love for us we seek to be God's people living and telling the story of Jesus.' In conversations with people from around the diocese about our vision in recent months, we have talked of all the different ways that we can serve the communities in which we are based - how we can enable the life of the whole of the people of God.

One of the community connections that many of our churches nurture is with their local school, in particular with our church schools where day in, day out teachers and their support staff reflect God's love and teachings with the pupils in their care. As rewarding as that role is, it is a tough one. The long summer holiday may be in sight but anyone who knows a teacher or member of school staff will tell you how much that is needed as well as how much work is done during that 'break'. They truly need our support and love and prayers. We should also give thanks for those working in our schools during the summer, cleaning, building, or preparing for the new academic year.

Not all of us are blessed with the gifts to teach, but many of us have other gifts that can help our school communities. For some it is the gift of storytelling, sharing the teachings of Jesus as an Open the Book volunteer, others serve as chaplains. Some will simply live out their Christian faith by volunteering in classrooms or in the playground or by praying regularly for the school community. All of these roles are valuable to our schools, and rewarding for those who fulfil them.

What our schools and Academy Trusts need in particular are governors and trustees. There are many opportunities, especially for foundation governors and trustees who have a distinct responsibility for championing the Christian character of our schools. That may sound daunting, but that responsibility isn't held alone as there is support locally and from our excellent diocesan education team. And if you do take on that role, what a joy to know that you are playing your part to support and nurture our young people in the way of our Lord who said, "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth." 3 John 1:4.

I enjoy running, playing the guitar, DIY and putting on the walking boots. Spending time with friends and family is always a joy.





150g pesto



EASY SUMMER CHICKEN BAKE



600g new potatoes
4 garlic cloves
8 free-range chicken thighs
2 tbsp olive oil
2 courgettes
200g cherry vine tomatoes



Heat the oven to 220°C/ 200°C fan/gas 7. Halve the new potatoes and peel the garlic cloves. Put the chicken thighs in a large roasting tin, then arrange the potatoes and garlic around them. Drizzle over the olive oil and season with salt and pepper, then roast for 40-45 minutes.

Meanwhile, slice the courgettes. When the chicken has been in the oven for 20 minutes, add the courgettes to the roasting tin.

For the final 10 minutes of the cooking time, add the tomatoes to the tin.

When the chicken is golden and cooked through, dollop over the pesto and serve.










A Prayer for Ukraine

SURPRISE RETURN TO WELLS







A friend's invitation, four hours to explore, meet at the Cathedral archway, by The Swan. An unexpected meeting with a young mason who had worked at Sherborne, Bath and Wells and handling St Botolph's chalice used at BCP Wednesday Services, with replicas of Christ the Apostles and Saints, from the World's finest medieval West Front sculpture, preceded this visit. A tower guided me, (the tallest of an English Parish Church) that morning. Two visitors from Arnhem another from Germany and I had mistaken St Cuthbert's (the Saxon Bishop of Lindisfarne 685AD), for the Cathedral. With a new Carolingian era, the Chapel of the Holy Trinity incorporated Royal Arms of Charles 1st and 2nd, a reminder from Henry 8th that C of E Churches were obliged to display allegiance to the Crown. Younger visitors might prefer to hear prisoners from 1685 battle at Sedgemoor were imprisoned here. Entrance to Wells Cathedral is by donation, the ticket enables a return within the year. Returning to the 12th Century Quire where my husband and I sat for matins in my working days, reminded us of student era reunions at the Burnham on sea Pageant. I was able to buy the choir's 2018 CD with Matthew Owen, "Awake my Soul", they were singing Choral Evensong at 3pm unfortunately after my departure.

Bank Holiday weekend and a hot day, encouraged me to the Bishop's Palace. A guide (£16 entrance) took us to the Chapel. I sat in Archbishop Laud's choir stall. No working lift, and to the steep climb to the drawing room, to see the chairs from previous coronations. Because of space, four times that of Charles 3rd congregation, we were shown the stool allocated, as there was no room to accommodate chairs used prior to Queen Elizabeth 2nd in 1953. Once the guide left, we were free to view individually. Kneeling in the corner of an upstairs room of the Bishop's Palace, was a young father and his son talking to each other and fitting large mounted pieces into a jigsaw model of a stained glass window. Such an excellent idea, it lay horizontally at a child's height, so co-operating together, the youngster would remember his Bank Holiday visit. In spite of numbers, there was a quiet in the hallowed surroundings, people lying on the lawns were respecting the ancient environment.

A pity it was not possible to buy a combined Cathedral/Bishop's Palace entry, but perhaps in the future, Visitor guides of the gardens. Time had run out.
